



Tennis Center Sand Point Junior Internship Program Requirements

- Intern programs are 8 weeks in length.
- Intern programs will be 4-5 hours per week.
- Intern programs can be used to satisfy a volunteer requirement for school purposes or other affiliated programs.
- Intern programs at TCSP focus on the Junior Program at TCSP, exposing interns to both teaching tennis and tennis administration.
- Interns are expected to be reliable, on-time, dress in proper attire, and act professionally to support TCSP's Code of Ethics.
- Interns must be 14 years of age by the first day of their internship.
- Interns will not be compensated for their time spent in the 8-week program.

Disclosure:

- The training that you receive at TCSP (while for the benefit of the Intern) is designed to provide insight to the tennis and coaching professions.
- Completion of the Intern program *does not* guarantee employment, but if a role happens to be open, you may apply, and completion of the program will be weighted in a decision to hire.
