TCSP Adult Team and League FAQs

How can I get onto a team?

Individuals who wish to play on a team can submit a request to be added to the waiting list at your NTRP. When a volunteer captain needs another player, the TCSP Team Coordinator will pass on wait list player information.

How do I request to captain a team?

Individuals can request to captain a team out of TCSP by submitting a request and a TCSP Team Application before the lottery date listed for each league. The team application form can be found on our website. All members of each team must be TCSP members.

Are you accepting Team applications for Cup Tennis?

No. We are not accepting any new Cup Tennis teams. We host 20 cup teams at various levels. Please see the table listed on the website for a list of all the teams offered at TCSP. Players can be added to the waiting list to be added to teams at all levels. When players are needed, the league coordinator will use this waiting list to fill teams.

How do you decide how many teams TCSP will host in each league?

Tennis Center Sand Point is able to host as many teams as it can in each league based on the amount of home matches we are able to provide on any given day. We are limited by our court availability. Each team we host is required to play exactly half of their matches at TCSP.

What is the difference between USTA and Cup Tennis?

Seattle Area Cup Tennis is a local, ladies only daytime league. The USTA league is nation wide and has male and female weekend and daytime leagues for all age groups.

What are the dates and deadlines for each league?

All league date information can be found on our website under adult league and team tennis.

How do team practices work?

Teams who wish to practice out of TCSP can only practice during the current league season. Practice dates are set in advance and are listed on the TCSP website. Teams who wish to practice will be charged for the entire season at once. We do not allow drop in's for team practices. Team practice times are determined by the TCSP Team Coordinator. In the event that we have more team practice requests than spots available, we will have a lottery for the available spots. Lottery information will be passed onto the captains in advance.

How do you charge our team members for practice?

The TCSP Team Coordinator will bill players once for the duration of the season. Players are charged the week of the team's first practice. All players will be billed on a house charge. Please be sure that all of your TCSP team members have a current membership and a card on file for practice billing.

Can TCSP home team members charge match fees to their house accounts?

Yes. The front desk will run individual house accounts for team matches if all team players have a house charge with a current credit card on file. In the event that a team member does not have this information on file, the charges for that player will be added to the team captain's account and can be settled on your own.

How are team matches scheduled?

League matches are scheduled by the USTA or cup tennis league based on general times we provide.

USTA matches can be rescheduled for three weeks after the match schedule is released.

Cup Tennis matches can be rescheduled at any time.

If you need to reschedule a match, please provide the TCSP Team Coordinator with some dates that work for both teams.

TCSP can only reschedule matches based on court availability. We do not guarantee that we will be able to accommodate every reschedule request.

What happens if a team needs to cancel a match court?

If you need to cancel a match court, please email the Team Coordinator 24 hours before the match. If you do not give us 24 hours, your team will be charged for both your teams and the visiting teams court fees.
